Footnotes

A. P. MAGIC chased the pace, moved to take over entering the stretch, responded when headed by HIGH CEILING and came on again to prevail. HIGH CEILING tracked the pace along the inside, steadied in behind rivals on the backstretch, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to gain a slim lead at the eighth pole but was outgamed to the wire. LEMON CREAM PIE rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and was gaining slowly on the top ones at the finish. INCULTO allowed to settle after bumping hard with UNSEPARABLE at the start, passed tired rivals in the drive. UNSEPARABLE reserved off the pace after being bounced around between rivals at the start, moved up to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't gain late. BRAVE APACHE bumped with UNSEPARABLE at the start, tracked the pace into the far turn and tired. VARITEK set the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then faltered. FAST CHARGER was not a factor. DUBAI DISTINCTION off slowly, saved ground and faded. ACORDION showed nothing.
