STORMY PLEASURE sprinted to a clear along the hedge, then responded to pressure in the drive and held GOTTA BALLADO safe. The latter, reserved early, advanced along the hedge on the far turn to reach the attending position in the stretch but couldn't gain on the winner late while proving second best. POPPI'S MATTHEW raced in striking position into the stretch and lacked a late response while holding the show. THE KAISER outrun early, passed tired rivals in the drive. DINERO steadied when caught in tight along the inside on the first turn, saved ground into the stretch and lacked a rally. TAMMANY STAR failed to menace. JOGO ANTIGO (BRZ) chased the winner into the far turn and tired. DANGER RANGER was outrun. MR MAJOR rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and faltered. JUAN TO DANCE was never a factor. SON OF ARAZI was done early. AZAT showed little.
