**Footnotes**

DREAMSPELL stalked the pace, eased out for the stretch run, rallied to catch BELLA CONTESSA nearing the sixteenth pole, then was fully extended to prevail. BELLA CONTESSA vied for the lead outside FRENCH CONCORDE to the eighth pole, then responded when challenged by DREAMSPELL soon after and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. CUTIE'S ROSIE well placed while saving ground, eased out and advanced to loom a threat at the eighth pole but had no further response. GREAT ESCAPE rated in striking position off the pace after being steadied in the early going and again on the first turn, gave way in the drive. FRENCH CONCORDE vied for the lead along the rail to the eighth pole, then tired. OPERA HALL steadied in the early going and again on the first turn, tracked the pace to nearing the stretch, then faltered. SPADE reserved off the pace, steadied repeatedly in behind the leaders for the first half mile, then was through after six furlongs. JABEZ unhurried early, rushed up along the outside after her rider's saddle slipped leaving the first turn, chased the leaders to the top of the stretch, then faded.
