**Footnotes**

APPTOBURN unhurried after breaking poorly, swung to the outside for the stretch run and rallied to be just up at the wire. CRUDEN BAY stumbled at the start, was forced wide on the first turn, raced four wide on the far turn, rallied to gain the lead nearing the sixteenth pole, then just failed to last. TRICKANOMETRY chased the pace, rallied to gain a slim lead outside AARONS SPECIAL at the eighth pole, then weakened. ST. GALO rated off the pace, lacked a late response. AARONS SPECIAL sprinted to a clear lead while drifting on the first turn, made the pace to nearing the eighth pole, then weakened. TIMELESS SANDS tracked the pace three wide into the far turn, then gave way. SARATOGA MATT off slowly, checked on the first turn, was angled in to save ground into the stretch, then checked again nearing the sixteenth pole and tired. ROADTOTHEFOREST steadied along the inside entering the first turn, chased the pace into the stretch and faltered. QUILL OUT drifted out on the first turn and was done early. PRICE IS A BARGAIN was outrun. NATIONAL CASE (SAF) showed little after breaking slowly and was vanned off after the finish.
