**Footnotes**

DANCE OF THE TIGER chased the pace, moved to gain command four wide midway of the turn, then drew off while drifting to the inside. QUEEN OF PEARLS chased the pace three wide around the turn but was no match for the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. ACCORDING TO ART unhurried early, raced four wide around the turn and closed to gain the show. INTERCOM chased the pace after breaking slowly, then checked in behind rivals midway of the turn and failed to recover. KAWEAH vied for the lead outside SADE DREAM to midway of the turn, then tired. FOR B. AND W. was no factor after being outrun early. YOU'RE TOO WILD unhurried after breaking slowly, was saving ground when steadied to avoid INTERCOM midway of the turn and never threatened. SECRET YACHT vied for the early lead and faltered. SADE DREAM vied for the lead along the rail to midway of the turn, then faded. BURNING FLIRT rated off the pace, steadied in behind INTERCOM midway of the turn and dropped back.
