OMAR'S TIGER tracked the leaders along the inside, angled three wide on the far turn, rallied to catch J ISLE at the eighth pole, then drew clear. J ISLE was showing speed when steadied to avoid running into the rail in the early going, set the pace under pressure along the rail, drew clear on the far turn but couldn't match strides with the winner in the final eighth while holding the place. BALTIMORE SAINT reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and closed to gain the show. MR. HADIF pressed the pace outside J ISLE into the far turn, then tired. JOEY THE SCHOLAR raced three wide and never threatened. PRIMARY WITNESS was not a factor. LIVE ON THE EDGE was outrun. SARATOGA MATT was outrun. PLUM CREEK saved ground and had no response when asked. SURELY SENT was never close.
