DON'T DIGRESS vied for the lead inside ACEY CASTELLI, came off the rail when that rival drew clear on the turn, then was no match while holding the place. WITCHES ABOVE unhurried after being steadied when bumped by GOOD DANCING early, closed to gain the show. GOOD DANCING bumped with WITCHES ABOVE early and was not a factor. S. S.'S GOLD HALO faltered while racing four wide. QUONOCHONTAUG chased the leaders three wide and faded. KISSIN LAINIE broke slowly and was through early.
