ICANSEECLEARLY stalked the pace off the rail, then responded to pressure in the drive and rallied to be just up at the wire. BAZARGAN sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, came off the rail for the stretch run and just failed to last. JUDGE RELIC KELIC tracked the pace, angled to inside on the far turn and lacked a late response. HY STYLE saved ground and was not a factor. TECHNICAL QUESTION was outrun. JEB'S LUCKY GIRL raced three wide and faded.
