MOCITA stalked the pace, rallied to catch AMERICAN MISS at the top of the stretch and drew away under urging. LEONA'S KNIGHT reserved along the inside, was steadied when caught in tight trying to get through inside PREACH IT entering the far turn, slipped through and closed to gain the place while no match for the winner. AMERICAN MISS chased the pace, moved to take over entering the far turn and opened a clear lead, then tired in the drive. SPECIAL REPORT failed to menace. INDIA HALO (ARG) was not a factor. PREACH IT set the pace to nearing the far turn, then stopped abruptly and was pulled up in the stretch.
