WIFELY DUTIES rated off the pace, angled three wide on the far turn, rallied to reach even terms for command in midstretch, then was fully extended to prevail. WEKIVA MIST stalked the pace along the hedge, was blocked in behind BLUE GRASS DANCER leaving the far turn and into the stretch, slipped through inside that rival to reach even terms for command just past the eighth pole and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. WOLF N HEN reserved off the pace after being steadied in traffic on the first turn, angled out leaving the far turn and split rivals to reach even terms for command at the eighth pole but was outgamed to the wire. TURN TO AVIE outrun early, rallied four wide around the far turn to reach contention in midstretch, then flattened out. BLUE GRASS DANCER set the pace along the inside to midstretch, then weakened. CALLTER unhurried early, saved ground and failed to menace. YOU ARE STORMY prompted the pace outside BLUE GRASS DANCER, then tired in the drive. MISS CHALICE was no factor while racing three wide. ATLANTICA off slowly, moved up to race in striking position four wide around the far turn and faltered. COMICAL JUDITH was through after a half mile. SHE'S OUR FAVORITE was outrun.
