CHEROKEE QUEEN tracked the pace three wide into the stretch, then rallied to be up in the final strides. ZIP TRICK set the pace along the inside into the stretch, then just failed to last. ENTERTAINING chased the pace into the stretch but had no late response. MUSICAL ROMANCE reserved off the pace, rallied to loom a threat in the stretch but didn't do enough late. BRINCA allowed to settle, steadied in traffic on the far turn and failed to menace. SUNDAY GEISHA chased the pace along the hedge, was caught in tight on the backstretch, continued to chase the pace into the stretch, then gave way. DANCING RAGE failed to menace. CAT CAN DO rated off the pace after being steadied along the inside on the first turn, tired leaving the far turn.
