Footnotes

SHARKBAIT OOH HAHA set the pace racing off the rail, responded when headed by VANISHING BUCK inside the eighth pole and came on again to prevail. VANISHING BUCK stalked the pace along the inside, eased out for the stretch run, rallied to gain a slim lead inside the eighth pole but was edged to the wire. MAXIMOSO stalked the pace to nearing the stretch, then tired. DIXIE SLAM bumped with MIMITO BOY at the start, tracked the pace into the far turn and faltered. MIMITO BOY was no factor after bumping with DIXIE SLAM at the start. BALTIMORE SAINT rated off the pace, faded on the far turn. FRATELLO showed little. FLIGHT TO FREEDOM was outrun and eased in the stretch run. POWER PARTS showed early foot, stopped and was eased in the stretch run.
