BACHELOR BLUES sprinted to a clear lead along the rail, made the pace into the stretch and was fully extended to last over NEW SCIENCE. The latter, well placed while saving ground, eased out for the stretch run and was gaining on the winner at the finish. SKIPEROO allowed to settle, saved ground to nearing the stretch, angled out for the drive and closed well for the show. BOLTIN' BRIAN chased the winner into the stretch and weakened. TURK'S RANSOM unhurried while saving ground, angled out in the stretch and closed ground late without threatening. FLIRT WITH FORTUNE allowed to settle, raced three wide on the far turn and was not a factor. WHAT A DR. was outrun. JOHN'S MECKE was done early. AFFIRMED RIZZI tracked the leaders into the far turn and faltered.
