Footnotes

MISTER SUPREMO chased the pace, rallied to catch GUNS DRAWN leaving the turn, then vied with that rival to nearing the sixteenth pole and edged away. GUNS DRAWN broke to the outside, was angled back in to show speed along the rail, responded when challenged by MISTER SUPREMO entering the stretch but couldn't stay with that rival late while holding the place. GOLD NATIVE unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run and found his best stride late. FOR APPEAL tracked the leaders along the inside into the stretch and gave way. HOLLYWOOD LEFT steadied to avoid GUNS DRAWN at the start, then steadied again along the inside racing down the backstretch, angled out to race three wide around the turn and tired. HONOR DUE well placed in behind the leaders around the turn, faltered. SAGAMORE was not a factor. JUMONVILLE was outrun while racing three wide.
