**Footnotes**

CLOSE BY tracked the pace, was steadied in traffic in the stretch, angled out for room and rallied along the outside to be just up at the wire. MARROUCHE unhurried early, eased out in the stretch and rallied between horses to just miss. SOUND CHECK set the pace along the rail, drew clear in the stretch, then just failed to last. BO'S SECRET STORM reserved off the pace after being steadied in behind PREMIER SOLDIER, didn't do enough late. BIG ROYAL ELTISH bumped with DARBY'S PAL at the start, moved up around the first turn to race with the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then gave way. DARBY'S PAL failed to menace after being jostled between rivals at the start. UNTUTTTABLE AFFAIR allowed to settle after bumping with DARBY'S PAL at the start, lacked a rally. BRED TO WIN pressed the pace outside SOUND CHECK to nearing the stretch, then tired. WISE WARRIOR well placed for a half mile, faltered. PREMIER SOLDIER up close early, bumped the rail on the first turn and faded.
