



MANDATED TO WIN stalked the pace, slipped through inside NIKKI'S WANTED TOO to gain the lead leaving the far turn, made the pace to nearing the eighth pole, then gave way. LADY CHARLIE broke well behind the field when she reared up at the start, moved up quickly to stalk the pace four wide into the stretch, then tired. NIKKI'S WANTED TOO set the pace off the rail to nearing the top of the stretch and faltered. SUCCESSFUL PARTY off slowly, was not a factor. T. S. FAY rank under restraint into the far turn, was outrun. DELIGHTFUL NICOLE chased the pace three wide into the far turn and faded.
