REGINA TWAIN rated off the pace, rallied three wide to gain the lead on the far turn, then edged away through the stretch under urging. PRIZES GALORE reserved after bumping hard with BAY POINT COUNTESS soon after the start, angled out on the far turn and made a run to reach the attending position but couldn't gain on the winner late while saving the place. D'LUCCI GIRL unhurried while saving ground, angled out for the drive and closed well to just miss the place. CHECKITOFF chased the pace, made a run to reach near even terms for command racing into the far turn, then tired. KALUKAHUA allowed to settle after bumping with BAY POINT COUNTESS soon after the start, made a run three wide to reach contention on the far turn, then faltered. TURN TIGER sprinted to clear lead along the inside, made the pace into the far turn, then had nothing left. BAY POINT COUNTESS stumbled when bumped between rivals in the early going and was never a factor.
