VENTANIA reserved off the pace, saved ground into the stretch, angled out and rallied to catch CUTIE'S ROSIE at the sixteenth pole, then drew clear. EL BENDINAT steadied in behind CUTIE'S ROSIE entering the first turn, stalked the leaders along the rail into the stretch, eased out and closed to gain the place while unable to match strides with the winner. CUTIE'S ROSIE vied for the lead along the rail, edged clear in the stretch, then gave way in the final sixteenth. SPECIAL JAK stalked the pace off the rail into the far turn and tired. WITCH'S ORCHARD stumbled at the start, stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, then faltered. LIGHT THE NORTH was through after a half mile. IMPERIAL STRIKE vied for the lead outside CUTIE'S ROSIE to nearing the stretch, then faded.
