ROMANESQUE pressed the pace outside MARCHING RHYTHM, took over from that rival on the far turn and opened a clear lead, then was all out to last over TWINING AND DINING. The latter, unhurried early, swung to the outside for the stretch run and closed well. TUSCANY LIGHT stalked the pace off the rail, was outmoved by the winner in early stretch, then didn't do enough late. SILVERY PET outrun while saving ground, angled out leaving the far turn and closed with a mild response. NATURAL ACTRESS trailed after breaking slowly, then passed tired rivals in the drive without threatening. FOREVER DILIGENT rated in striking position off the pace, saved ground into the stretch and tired. MARCHING RHYTHM set the pace under pressure along the rail into the far turn and gave way. STARSHIP BULLETIN tracked the pace three wide into the far turn and faltered. RAISE THE LEVEL raced four wide and faded. RARE HONOR was through after a half mile.
