FORTUNATE TRAIL bumped with HANDSOME BRUNO at the start, vied for the lead outside TRUE GENIUS into the turn, then drew away under urging. DENNIS'S DREAM rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and closed to prove second best while drifting in. TRUE GENIUS vied for the lead along the inside into the turn, then couldn't stay with the winner and tired in the drive. HANDSOME BRUNO bumped with FORTUNATE TRAIL and checked at the start, raced four wide around the turn, then improved his position without threatening. D. L. RENZO steadied from tight quarters soon after the start and failed to menace. FORTUNATE BUY was caught in tight at the start, saved ground around the turn and faltered. LEONARD was no factor while racing three wide. DINNER BACKSTAGE chased the pace three wide around the turn and had nothing left for the drive. ZOOMBA steadied in the early going, chased the pace to midway of the turn, then faded.
