SACRED CLASS reserved off the pace, angled three wide on the far turn, rallied to gain command approaching the quarter pole while still in hand, then drew off while being kept to the task. LA MALANDRINA set the pace along the rail to past midway of the far turn, then was no match for the winner while just saving the place. COURTNEY RYAN tracked the pace off the rail, then closed to just miss the place while never a threat to the winner. KATE'S HOLIDAY hit the gate at the start, raced in contention four wide to nearing the stretch, then tired. KIOWA stalked the pace three wide to the quarter pole and faltered. EMMA'S FIRST TOUR prompted the pace off the rail to midway of the far turn, then faded. AUDREY was through after a half mile.
