### Footnotes

MIAMI CAT set the pace under pressure along the inside, then drew off through the stretch when asked. MR. ESPRESSO reserved while saving ground, angled out at the top of the stretch and closed to prove second best while unable to stay with the winner. SILVER DISTINCTION stalked the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then tired. NIAM'S STRIKE rated off the pace, angled in leaving the far turn, then was checked in early stretch when unable to get through inside TURBO CANNON and failed to recover. TURBO CANNON pressed the pace outside MIAMI CAT to the quarter pole, then faltered. JACKWAGON was through after a half mile. FINANCIAL PATHWAY trailed and was eased in the stretch run. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY AND THE RIDER OF NIAM'S STRIKE LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST SEVERAL RIVALS FOR ALLEDGED INTERFERENCE IN EARLY STRETCH. THE CLAIM OF FOUL WAS NOT ALLOWED.
