COZY KITTEN rated off the pace, rallied four wide around the far turn engage the leader entering the stretch, moved to take over at the eighth pole, then edged away under pressure. RHUBARB SAUCE vied for the lead along the rail, responded when challenged by COZY KITTEN entering the stretch, stayed with that rival to just past the eighth pole, then weakened. SKY MASTERSON stalked the pace along the rail, eased out in the stretch and had no late response while edging MAJESTIC MAN for the show. The latter, reserved off the pace, advanced into contention three wide around the far turn but couldn't gain on the top ones after his rider lost his whip inside the eighth pole. FARMERS MARKET unhurried while saving ground, swung out leaving the far turn and never threatened. LEVERAGED LOAN steadied in behind the leaders racing into the first turn, stalked the pace off the rail, then tired in the drive. ALFIE COME HOME bumped by MAKE OUT MAN at the start, vied for the lead outside RHUBARB SAUCE to nearing the stretch, then faltered. MAKE OUT MAN bumped with ALFIE COME HOME at the start, then bore out on the first turn, angled back in and was through after a half mile.
