WHAT A PAL chased the pace along the rail, eased outside J HENRY in the stretch and rallied to be up late. J HENRY showed speed off the rail to deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner while clearly best of the rest. TIME FOR JACKIE bumped with ATLANTIC TIME at the start, raced four wide around the turn and closed to be up for the show while no threat to the top ones. PRINCESS NIKKI chased the leaders three wide around the turn and tired. YOUCAN'T TUNEAFISH showed early foot and faltered. ATLANTIC TIME was outrun after bumping with TIME FOR JACKIE at the start. CLASSY GRAY showed brief speed and faded.
