Footnotes

FAIR WHIT set the pace off the rail, drew clear around the far turn, then remained clear to the wire under pressure. POWER RULES reserved off the pace after being steadied soon after the start, rallied to prove second best. BARRA D'ORO rated off the pace, saved ground and closed to be up for the show while unable to stay with the top ones. NATHAN RIDGE off slowly, raced in striking position off the rail to the top of the stretch, then tired. NINEINTHENINE raced four wide and failed to menace. SIR CHARLIE bumped at the start, raced three wide into the far turn and faltered. CHISELED LIGHT bumped FAST JAK at the start and was through after a half mile. FAST JAK was knocked into SIR CHARLIE at the start, chased the pace three wide into the far turn, then couldn't stay with the winner and faded.
