CHARLIE PAPA set the pace along the rail into the stretch, then drew clear under urging. EL BANK ROBBER reserved early, angled out for the stretch and closed with a mild response to gain the place. SILVERSIDER rated off the pace, steadied in behind rivals on the backstretch and again in behind A SEA TRIPPI entering the turn, then closed to be up for the show. BEREBA pressed the pace into the stretch, then gave way. SEND ME AN ANGEL bobbled at the start, chased the pace along the inside into the stretch and weakened. A SEA TRIPPI steadied in traffic on the backstretch, raced three wide around the turn and was not a threat. BALERIANA (PER) showed early foot, then steadied when caught in tight entering the turn and faltered.
