**Footnotes**

CHAPEL RUN chased the pace three wide, rallied to take over entering the stretch, then was fully extended to prevail. BONBONI tracked the pace off the rail into the stretch, then was gaining on the winner at the finish. GIMMEAWINKPOPPY vied for the lead outside CHAMPION ECLIPSE, edged clear from that rival midway of the turn, then gave way in the drive. SPOTLIGHT SCAM rated off the pace, steadied in traffic on the backstretch, remained in contention into the stretch but couldn't keep pace with the top ones. MAGESTIC BILL off slowly, failed to menace. NICHOLAS VISION was not a factor. CELLARS CABERNET was never a threat after stumbling at the start. A QUESTION OF TIME stalked the pace along the inside around the turn and tired. SOULFULLY was outrun. AGAIN ELEVEN showed little while racing wide throughout. CHAMPION ECLIPSE vied for the lead along the inside into the turn, then faltered. DUST DEVIL well placed early, steadied in traffic on the backstretch and faded. The rider of SPOTLIGHT SCAM lodged an objection against the rider of BONBONI for alleged interference on the backstretch. The claim of foul was not allowed.
