TESORO DE AMOR reserved off the pace, steadied in in behind rivals on the first turn, advanced along the inside around the far turn, eased outside BET ON THE BLUE and rallied to be up late. BET ON THE BLUE set the pace along the inside into the stretch but couldn't resist the winner in the final sixteenth. CHISTOSA prompted the pace outside BET ON THE BLUE to nearing the stretch, then gave way. MISS ARISTOCRAT tracked the leaders three wide to the quarter pole, then tired. BOB'S JAWBREAKER was not a factor. MARGARET SMILE tracked the leaders four wide to the quarter pole, then faltered. KNOCKINELDER steadied in behind the leader on the first turn, saved ground, faded and was eased in the stretch run.
