JARANERO set the pace along the inside, responded when challenged by OLD PARR on the far turn, then dueled with and just edged that rival to the wire. OLD PARR stalked the pace, moved up to engage JARANERO on the far turn, then dueled with that one to the wire and just missed. ZUBER stalked the pace into the stretch and tired. WILD APACHE rank under restraint in the early going, tracked the pace along the inside into the far turn, then faltered. CALPULLEC rated off the pace after breaking through the gate prior to the start, raced three wide and faded leaving the far turn.
