SAINT JUDE rated off the pace, rallied four wide around the far turn, moved to gain the lead at the eighth pole, then was all out to just last over NUMB LIPS. The latter, unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn, then rallied outside SAINT JUDE to just miss. UMBRAGGIO outrun early, closed with a belated rally to gain the show. STORM WARNINGS tracked the pace while saving ground, advanced around the far turn to reach contention, then gave way in the drive. HAVANADAYDREAM set the pace under pressure along the rail into the stretch, then tired. DON'T LOCK ME OUT chased the pace three wide into the stretch and faltered. SOUTHAFRICAN QUEEN reserved racing along the rail, was steadied when she bumped the rail leaving the far turn and never threatened. TELLUM BERTO stumbled at the start, pressed the pace outside HAVANADAYDREAM to the top of the stretch, then faded.
