IMPERIAL CZAR chased the pace three wide, rallied to gain a slim lead outside ALLEY OOP OOP at the quarter pole, then prevailed in a long drive. ALLEY OOP OOP showed speed along the inside, responded when headed by IMPERIAL CZAR at the quarter pole, was vying with that rival when his rider lost his whip inside the eighth pole and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. MOTIN unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and closed well for the show. TRUELEE SCRAPPIN well placed in behind the leaders, raced three wide around the turn and had no late response. SIR CHARLIE off a step slowly, moved up down the backstretch to track the leaders around the turn, then weakened. CAPT. ZIPPOUNAS showed speed off the rail into the turn and faltered.
