QUANACO chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over on the far turn and drew clear but couldn't match strides with the winner late. OUR FINALE outran early, passed tired rivals in the drive to gain the show. STORY GRINDER steadied from tight quarters soon after the start, moved up to chase the leaders three wide into the far turn, then tired. JAMIE'S BAD BOY set the pace along the inside into the far turn and gave way. MISTY WONDER up close in the early going, faltered. NUMBER chased the pace for a half mile and faded.
