Footnotes

LARGE KAUFY showed speed along the rail, then drew away through the stretch under urging. MEL BEACH chased the pace three wide, was steadied to avoid SKIBO IN JULY on the turn, recovered and closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. JORDAN'S IMAGE allowed to settle after being steadied when bumped at the start, angled to the outside in the stretch and finished willingly to just miss the place. MY BAMBINO rated off the pace after bobbling at the start, closed with a mild response. SKIBO IN JULY off slowly, was chasing the pace when steadied to avoid running up on a rival leaving the backstretch, angled three wide on the turn to continue chasing the winner into the stretch, then tired. SALT WATER COWBOY reserved while saving ground, checked to avoid running up on ED EARLY nearing the eighth pole and failed to threaten. HOV LANE was outrun. ZEBULON ROAD was no factor after breaking slowly. ED EARL bumped JORAND'S IMAGE at the start, pressed the pace outside LARGE KAUFY to midway of the turn, then faded.
