Footnotes

ALARMING AFLEET moved through along the inside to take over entering the backstretch, repulsed a bid from BUSHMILLS BEST on the far turn, opened a clear lead in midstretch, then was fully extended to prevail in a game effort. BRIDLED QUEST reserved off the pace, advanced along the inside around the far turn, his rider lost his whip in early stretch, then was gaining slowly on the top one at the finish. MARAQUERO outrun early, rallied to reach contention entering the stretch, then flattened out. BUSHMILLS BEST stalked the pace, moved up to reach even terms for command on the far turn, then tired in the drive. A BIT OF MADNESS tracked the pace into the far turn and faltered. PACKER unhurried early, steadied in traffic on the far turn and never threatened. A FLEET PROSPECTOR showed brief speed off the rail, then had nothing left. TRYING BRIAN raced three wide into the far turn, faded and was eased in the final eighth.
