MOREAPPLAUSEPLEASE allowed to settle, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to catch BROWN DIRT COWBOY inside the sixteenth pole and won going away. BROWN DIRT COWBOY chased the pace three wide, rallied to take over entering the stretch, made the pace to deep stretch and was outfinished. FIORE DICAMPO chased the pace along the inside into the stretch and weakened. BIG JOHN G off slowly, chased the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. NANA'S APPEAL showed speed along the inside to nearing the stretch, then tired. BUSHMILLS BEST well placed early, raced four wide around the turn and faltered. DIRTKICKER hit the gate at the start and failed to menace. SUNSET ESCAPADE steadied soon after the start and was outrun. CUCINA NICK was done early.
