**Footnotes**

OMAR'S TIGER quickly sprinted to a clear lead racing off the rail, made the pace into the stretch, then was fully extended to hold sway. SAINT NICHOLAS unhurried early, angled out for the drive and rallied to prove second best. THE SUN DEMON rated in striking position off the pace after being bumped by BARBARO'S REVENGE at the start, moved into contention leaving the far turn but had no further response. BARBARO'S REVENGE reserved off the pace after bumping THE SUN DEMON when he stumbled at the start, closed with a mild response. BLACK OPS HONOR chased the pace along the rail into the stretch, then tired. TESTED well placed while saving ground, faltered in the drive. ISLAND DREAMING was outrun. MONTANA MAN was not a factor. TASSO'S AFFAIR tracked the early pace along the inside, then hit the rail entering the far turn and dropped back. ROMAN GUITAR chased the pace into the far turn, then faded.
