VITAL VICTORY steadied from close quarters on the backstretch, angled four wide on the turn, rallied quickly to gain command entering the stretch, then drew off under urging. ONE MORE FOR BRITT allowed to settle, raced four wide around the turn and closed to prove best of the rest while no match for the winner. MIA ROSE raced with the pace four wide, took over on the turn and opened a clear lead, then gave way in the drive. GIBSON'S LIL GRACE vied for the lead along the inside into the turn and tired. CADENCE'S ACCOLADE vied for the lead between horses into the turn and faltered. MAY RIVER rated off the pace after breaking slowly, had nothing left for the drive. DANCE COCOA DANCE was never close after she dwelt badly at the start. HER PRIVATE LIFE off slowly, was outrun. RED HOT ONE vied for the lead three wide into the turn and faded.
