Footnotes

CONGRATS CRIMINAL tracked the pace in early stages, continued behind the leader heading into the far turn, dug in the upper stretch, steadily gained position to the lead and raced past EL COWBOY in the final furlong. EL COWBOY rushed up to take command at the start, continued the clear leader heading into the far turn, pressured by eventual winner nearing midstretch, could not keep up the pace and finished second best. EL KIWI stalked the pace two off the inside in the backstretch, saved ground along the rail in the far turn and kept raced along for show position in the drive. HARDTAP stalked the pace in early stages, shifted out nearing the quarter pole and finished three to four wide in the lane. LANCE'S SONG raced two to three wide into the lane and lacked late needed kick in the drive. GUTS TO GLORY moved up three wide nearing the far turn but failed to sustain bid in the drive. HONOR'S GOLD tracked the top two leaders in the backstretch but could not keep up the pace nearing the far turn and faltered in the drive. VALUEABLE SILVER raced up along the rail after the start, checked out sharply leaving the backstretch, eased up in the drive and vanned off after the race.
