TWIRLING ANGEL reserved racing along the rail, passed tired rivals for the show. MONARQUICA rated off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and tired. TWINING GLOW was outrun. BLUZING chased the pace into the stretch and faltered. ITALIAN SLEW unhurried early, steadied when caught in tight approaching the end of the backstretch and trailed.
