MONEY TO BURN showed speed along the inside into the stretch, then drew off under urging. TO MONARCH chased the winner into the stretch but was no match for that rival while continuing on with good courage for the place. EXCEL reserved racing along the inside, steadied on the turn, remained in contention into the stretch, then tired. REINSTATEMENT failed to menace after bumping with WHIP THE GROOM at the start. FREEFROMTHEBOX was not a factor. TREY bumped soundly with WHIP THE GROOM at the start and was never a threat. BOX OF ACES was outrun. WHIP THE GROOM trailed after being squeezed back at the start.
