GRAN MISTERIO raced just off the leader in early stages, allowed to settle back slightly leaving the backstretch tracking the set of duelers, angled out slightly nearing the far turn, edged up to the lead with a furlong left to go, dueled along the outside of DIVINE MICHAEL in the deep stretch, dug in and prevailed in final strides. DIVINE MICHAEL broke through the gate pre start, tracked just off the leader in opening stages, edged up to the lead with three furlongs left to run, dueled with BOLD SHADOW into the far turn, took command at the top of the lane, challenged by eventual winner with a furlong left to go and could not hold in final strides. BOLD SHADOW rushed up to take command heading into the first turn, continued to set the pace by a narrow margin over rivals, challenged by DIVINE MICHAEL near the three eighths pole, battled along the inside of rival for the lead, could not match strides in the far turn and raced along for show in the drive. EMPEROR'S TUNE hopped up at the start and came away last, moved up to stalk the leaders along the inside in the backstretch, urged for response at the top of the lane but failed to rally in the drive. GIDDY UP AMIGO saved ground racing along the rail in the far turn and failed to be a threat in the drive. SPANISH WINK stalked the pace three wide in the backstretch and faded after a half mile.
