**Footnotes**

BECAUSE A BONNIE showed speed along the inside, drew clear in midstretch, then was fully extended to prevail. INDIAN SUMMER GIRL chased the pace three wide around the turn and rallied to be up for the place. THIEF IN STYLE reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and finished willingly to just miss the place. HOPE TO DANCE off slowly, was rated off the pace, angled out for the drive and was gaining on the winner at the finish. DAYLIGHT TIME chased the pace into the stretch and tired. MY KIP allowed to settle, steadied in traffic on the backstretch and faded.
