### Footnotes

SAILING CLEAR vied for the lead outside IN RHYTHM, edged away from that rival in early stretch, then was fully extended to hold off PRINCE OF SPEED. The latter, chased the pace three wide into the stretch and continued on with good courage to prove best of the rest while unable to get to the winner. NO ACT reserved early, angled four wide on the turn and gained the show while unable to get to the top ones. IN RHYTHM vied for the lead along the inside, then tired in the drive. BIDHAM steadied in the chute, stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch and faltered. FATHER LUCEY rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, then faded. IN SPEIGHT OF IT steadied soon after the start and was done early.
