SWEET IRISH ROSE stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, then couldn't match strides with the winner while clearly best of the rest. CUTIE'S ROSIE stalked the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, then tired. GREAT ESCAPE prompted the pace outside TALAVISTA to midway of the far turn and faltered. WHY SHOULD I was never a factor. AMIE LYNN rated off the pace, raced three wide and faded. JABEZ was done early. COME SEE COME SA was through after a half mile.
