JUGGERNAUT vied for the lead along the inside around the turn, then drew clear through the stretch under urging. LAWBOOK vied for the lead outside JUGGERNAUT into the the stretch, then couldn't stay with that rival while clearly second best. BOG HUNTER unhurried early, raced four wide around the turn and closed to be just up for the show while no threat to the top ones. SAY NO MAW failed to menace. BARNACLE STEVE stumbled at the start, raced with the pace three wide to nearing the stretch and tired. CHOW DOWN showed brief speed along the inside, angled four wide on the turn and faltered in the drive. NICK'S NOACTOR showed little.
