PRIME PRECISION prompted the pace outside RUN JAMAICAN'S RUN, took over from that rival on the far turn, was allowed to drift out a bit entering the stretch, then edged away under pressure. BOB'S JAWBREAKER chased the pace three wide into the stretch, was angled inside PRIME PRECISION and couldn't stay with that rival while proving best of the rest. RUN JAMAICAN'S RUN set the pace along the inside to midway of the far turn, then gave way. WHO PLAYS BRAHMS tracked the pace into the stretch but had no response when asked. S S SERAPHIM was outrun. KALUKAHUA rank and steadied to avoid running up on rivals in the early going, was never a factor. SKY CAP showed little. SPECIAL JAK well placed for a half mile, faltered.
