MEAN SAX set the pace along the hedge into the stretch and was fully extended to prevail. BLACK SCORPION steadied in behind the leader on the first turn, stalked that rival along the inside, eased out for the stretch run and didn't do enough late. DINNER IN ODEM reserved off the pace, saved ground and closed with a mild response to be up for the show. FEARLESS EAGLE tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and had no late response. GRAND CASH failed to menace. IMAWILDANDCRAZYGUY saved ground to no avail. POUND FOOLISH off slowly, was not a factor. SCOOTIN SCOOTER chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then tired.
