SIMPLY IMPRESSIVE set the pace along the rail, drew clear in early stretch, then was all out to just last over MISS OLIVIA RAE. The latter, outrun after breaking slowly, raced four wide around the far turn, then rallied to just miss. WINSOCKIE chased the winner into the stretch but didn't do enough late. MINISTREL LISA stumbled at the start, chased the pace along the rail into the stretch but had no late response. FOR TERINA reserved in striking position off the pace, lacked a rally. SWEETDREAMIN LACEY chased the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. FUTURE HEIRESS failed to menace. ANGEL'S COVE steadied along in behind rivals leaving the first turn, tracked the pace into the far turn and tired. MY SWEET MAUREEN unhurried after breaking poorly, was saving ground when steadied from tight quarters on the far turn, then faltered.
