Footnotes

LIBERTY ST. OUTLAW stalked the pace off the rail, moved to gain command on the far turn, then drew off while being kept to pressure. SOLE RUNNER set the pace along the inside into the far turn, then was no match for the winner while just saving the place. SUN SCORPION unhurried early, angled four wide on the far turn and closed to just miss the place while no threat to the winner. WICKLOW ROYALE reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and had no response when asked. PRINCE HAZEEM was not a factor. CELLARS CABERNET saved ground and tired. SICCARDI rated off the pace, faltered in the drive. PUCHADOR tracked the leaders off the rail to nearing the stretch, then faded.
