Footnotes

SPECIAL COACH forced the pace racing along the hedge, edged away after entering the stretch and prevailed while drifting out under left handed pressure. MONKEY PUZZLE, unhurried early, circled rivals five wide on the far turn and closed well for the place. PRESS TYPE, rated off the pace, angled three wide entering the stretch to make a run at the leader, then weakened. DANCE THE BALLADO, reserved after being steadied at the start, was in tight between rivals on the far turn, angled out for the stretch run and lacked the needed rally. WERTZ set the pace under pressure outside SPECIAL COACH and tired. TIMELY CHANGE, well placed, lacked a late response. SIBERCRASHER, allowed to settle, made run four wide on the far turn to loom a threat, then faltered. THROWTHEBOOKATEM failed to reach contention. SMART BUILDER hit the gate hard at the start, saved ground and faded. LITTLE LEE chased the pace three wide and gave way. MISSIONARY AL was through after a half mile. LOCKED ON was outrun.
